


If You Are Injured on the Job

- I. If you need emergency medical attention CALL 911!
- 2. If not, notify your supervisor immediately.
- 3. Obtain the required forms from you supervisor.
- 4. Have someone drive you to one of the Town's Medical Providers (see other side). Do not go to your personal doctor!
- 5. Return the completed forms to your supervisor.





After Your Medical Treatment

- I.Follow the doctors orders (treatment and work restrictions)
- 2. Contact:

 soon as possible.

- 3.Be on time for follow up visits or physical therapy
- 4. Cooperate with the NCLM Claims Adjuster.

Supervisors of Injured Employees

- I. If your employee needs emergency medical attention CALL 911!
- 2. Give the employee a signed Medical Authorization Form
- 3. Call the medical provider and tell them you are coming.
- 4. Take the employee (or have them driven) to the medical provider.
- 5. With in 24 hrs complete, and sign, the Form 19 and the Town's Accident Investigation report.

 Take pictures if needed.
- 6. Obtain the completed medical forms from the employee and discuss the medical restrictions.
- 7. Keep a copy of all forms and forward all originals to Mike Beckman, Occupational Health & Safety Officer.
- 8. Notify your Payroll & Benefits Rep. if the employee is going to miss time or will be on Return to Work, restricted duty.
- 9. Keep in touch with your employee while they recover.
- 10. If you have question, contact Mike Beckman, Occupational Health & Safety Officer as soon as possible. Located in Town Hall HRD (919) 969-5035
