


# **DOT Project - Franklin Street Resurfacing**

#### SCOPE

Franklin Street from Columbia Street to Eastgate Shopping Center will be resurfaced to facilitate safe and efficient transportation downtown.

#### **IMPACTS**

For Franklin Street from Columbia Street to Pickard Lane: nighttime lane closures are permitted between 9pm and 6am, Monday through Sunday.



From Pickard Lane to the Eastgate Shopping Center: daytime lane closures are permitted between 9 am and 4pm, Monday through Sunday.


No Chapel Hill Transit detours are scheduled.

# **DOT Project - Columbia and Pittsboro St. Resurfacing**

#### SCOPE

This project includes resurfacing
Columbia Street from the intersection
with Franklin Street to the intersection
with Pittsboro Street, all of Pittsboro
Street, and Columbia Street back to
Cameron Avenue.



#### **IMPACTS**

Lane closures are permitted between 9pm and 6am, Monday through Sunday.

No Chapel Hill Transit detours are scheduled.

# **Town Project - Friday Center Dr. Reconstruction**

#### **SCOPE**

This project includes reconstruction of the Town maintained portion of Friday Center Drive (from the intersection with NC-54 just past the driveway to the Friday Center). The project will include ADA improvements and restriping of the roadway to accommodate a 5-6' bike lane.



#### **IMPACTS**

Two-way traffic will be maintained with lane closures. No Chapel Hill Transit route detours are anticipated. Periodic bus delays may occur due to construction activity.

LATE JUNE/ EARLY JULY THROUGH FALL 2018

# Developer Project - Eubanks Rd. Widening

#### SCOPE

Road reconstruction to four lanes with a median. This project is related to the Carraway Village Development.

#### **IMPACTS**

Lane closures expected between 9 am and 4 pm, with occasional lane closures at night. Staff is working with the developer to ensure there is no interruption in Town and County services as a result of the road improvements.

#### **IMPACTS**

Slight traffic delays as road improvements occur on Old Durham Rd. Staff will continue to work with the developer to ensure needed closures occur during the least impactful times of the day.

# **Carraway Village**



#### **IMPACTS**

Lane closures expected between 9 am and 4 pm, with occasional lane closures at night. Staff is working with the developer to ensure there is no interruption in Town and County services as a result of the road improvements.

## **Chapel Hill Retirement Residence**



#### **IMPACTS**

This project should not affect school traffic. Staff will continue to work with the developer to ensure needed closures occur during the least impactful times of the day.



#### **IMPACTS**

This project should also not affect school traffic. Staff will continue to work with the developer to ensure needed closures occur during the least impactful times of the day.

## **Glen Lennox**



#### **IMPACTS**

Minimal traffic impacts along the Fordham Blvd side that borders the project. Hays Road and Brandon Road will be closed during this redevelopment project and traffic will be detoured.

## Hillstone



#### **IMPACTS**

Minor traffic delays anticipated with construction vehicles entering and exiting Legion Road or the service road

# **Chapel Hill High School**



#### **IMPACTS**

The construction process is scheduled to start once school ends. There will be construction activities occurring during the next school year, but the school is not expecting the construction to affect school schedule nor traffic.



# **Sidewalks and Bike Ped Improvements**

Bike Ped Improvements

#### Estes Drive Bike Ped

Constructing bicycle and pedestrian facilities along Estes Drive from Marin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to Caswell Road. Includes bike lanes and sidewalks on the north and south sides of Estes Drive and an off-road multi-use trail on the north side. Flags outlining easements on private property are placed along the project. Construction in fall 2018. #### Old Durham Rd Bike Ped

Installing five-foot sidewalks and five-foot bike lanes (NCDOT project) in the Chapel Hill section. The NCDOT has initiated acquisition of right of way for the Chapel Hill section, US 15-501 to Pope Road. Construction will begin late summer 2018. The Durham portion of the project, Pope Road to Garrett Road, is underway. Clearing for utility installation is complete Old Durham Chapel Hill Road within Chapel Hill Town Limits.

# **Utility Projects - OWASA**



### **Old Durham Rd**

Infrastructure improvements for the Wegmans development site.

#### **Pritchard Avenue**

Lane closures will be permitted between 7am and 6 pm on Pritchard Ave.
 Pritchard will also include a tie-in to the waterline on Rosemary St.

# Utility Projects – MCNC Fiber Installation on E Franklin St./ Hwy 15-501

#### SCOPE

Installing fiber cable from the intersection of E Franklin St and Estes Drive to the Durham City limits along Hwy 15/501.

MCNC is coordinating with NCDOT resurfacing.



#### **IMPACT**

Minor traffic delays expected. MCNC will be working in the right-of-way.

## **Utility Projects – Estes Drive Gas Transmission Line**

#### SCOPE

PSNC Energy will replace 1.5 miles of an existing pipeline in Chapel Hill. The new pipeline will be installed within current PSNC Energy right-of-way east of the intersection of Estes Drive and Somerset Drive, and will follow Estes Drive until its intersection with Fordham Boulevard.

#### **IMPACT**

Significant traffic impact is anticipated on Estes Drive. PSNC is coordinating with NCDOT resurfacing. More information to come regarding traffic impact.




Economic Impact: Carraway Village will be a great gateway to showcasing who we are upon first entering our community.
