
### **Company History**



- Multinational Swiss/Swedish company founded in 1883 and headquartered in Zurich, Switzerland
- 160,000 employees in over 100 countries; \$18 billion in sales
- 24,000 employees & 65 manufacturing locations in the U. S.
  - Includes 3,000 jobs & \$45 million in annual payroll in North Carolina
  - Orange County factory was purchased from GE in 2018, and is the #1 largest private employer in Orange County.
- Five market-leading entrepreneurial divisions:
  - Electrification Products
  - Power Grids
  - Industrial Automation
  - Robotics & Discrete Automation
  - Motion Control (Industrial motors & drives, traction control)

#### **Company History**

- Began in Chicago in 1910 as Northwestern
- Garment Factory; became MEDCO, and renamed Medline Industries in 1966; based in Northfield, IL
- Facility presence in 20 countries
  - Serves customers in 90+ countries
- \$12 billion in annual sales; owner of "Curad" adhesive bandages
- 24,000 employees worldwide (8,300 new jobs added since 2014)
- Largest privately held manufacturer and distributor of medical supplies in the United States:
  - 43 medical grade distribution centers totaling 20 million sq. ft.
  - 30 manufacturing centers producing 80,000 medical products
  - 50+ distribution centers worldwide, including North America, Europe, Asia and Australia, with 600,000 Medline-brand and national brand products
  - 2+ month of Medline-brand product inventory is held for each customer to protect against unplanned demand increases and natural disaster response
  - Primary supplier to U.S. Department of Homeland Security
  - Fleet of 750 company-owned delivery trucks






#### **Company History**

- Medline's 1.2 million sq. ft. Orange County facility will be <u>LEED</u> certified and have rooftop-mounted solar panels that will supply 35% 50% of all electricity needs.
- Regionally, Medline operates two 400,000 sq. ft. distribution centers in Lincolnton, NC (photo below) and Richmond, VA.
