BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

- Total budget = \$143,696,978
- 11% increase from prior year
- Tax increase of 5 cents
- Property tax rate of 57.2 cents
- 5% Cost of Living adjustment

BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

- Have not had a significant tax increase for General Fund in fifteen years
- Cost of doing Town business has gone up significantly and Council has some big, bold goals
- Prioritizes our employees and the core services they provide
- Acts as a force multiplier for catching up on our backlog AND kickstarting Council goals

ENTERPRISE FUNDS HIGHLIGHTS



TRANSIT

- 2.2% increase in overall budget
- No tax increase; flat contribution for UNC & Carrboro
- \$400K increase in federal & state assistance
- \$530K lapsed salary adjustment to balance budget



- 0.5% decrease in overall budget
- \$1.2 million from Debt Service to balance budget

ENTERPRISE FUNDS HIGHLIGHTS



- 1.6% increase in budget
- No stormwater fee increase
- Future impact of NPDES requirements



- 7% increase in overall budget
- HUD contributions (51%), rent revenue (47%) and fund balance/other income (2%)
