

- 2. CROSS SLOPE: 2.00%
- 3. CURB RAMPS REQUIRE A (4'-0") MINIMUM LANDING WITH A MAXIMUM CROSS SLOPE AND LONGITUDINAL SLOPE OF 2.00% WHERE PEDESTRIANS PERFORM TURNING MANEUVERS. SLOPE TO DRAIN TO CURB.
- 4. CONSTRUCT THE WINGS (X) WITH A CURB FACE SLOPE 12:1 OR HIGHER.
- 5. PLACE TRUNCATED DOME FINISH ON THE RAMP PARALLEL WITH THE CURB.
- 6. PLACE CONTRACTION JOINTS AND EXPANSION JOINTS SCORELINES AS SHOWN.
- 7. OPTIONAL BACKING CURB FOR LANDSCAPE SUPPORT.
