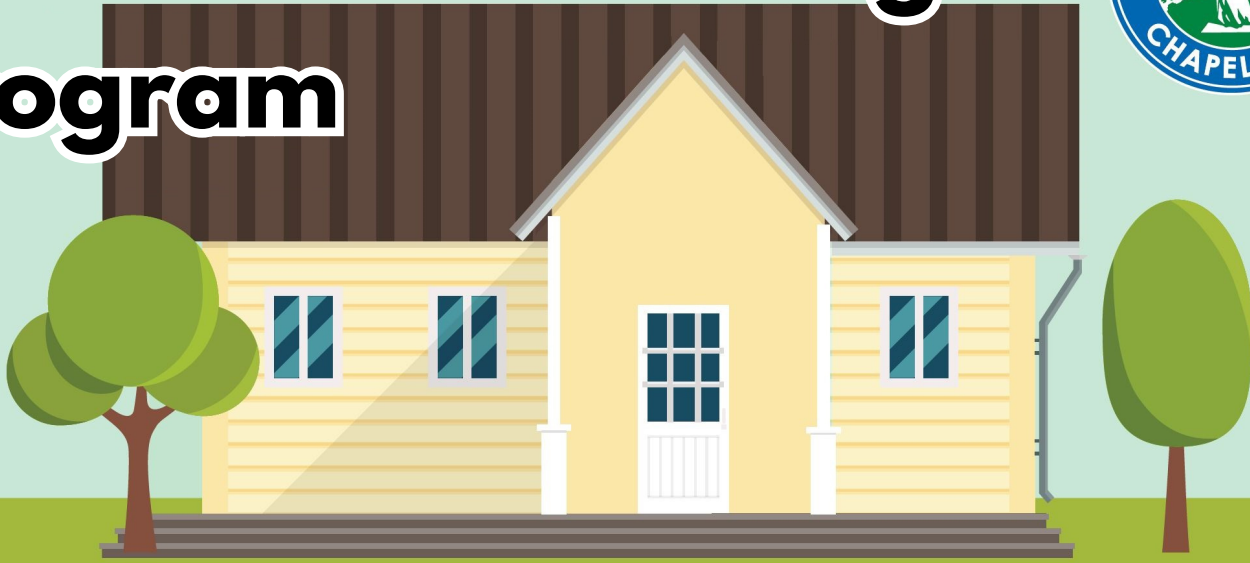

Transitional Housing Program

Program Incentives

- Maintain current monthly rent, even if your family income increases.
- Auto-deposit 20% of your monthly rent in a savings account to buy or rent a home in Orange County in the future.
- Receive case management and access local agency programs to work towards your personal financial and housing goals.
- Participate in the program for five years.

To apply, current residents must meet the following criteria:

- Pay at least \$450/month in rent.
- Pay your rent on time and have not had any lease violations in the past 12 months.
- Want to establish personal savings, housing goals, and live in private market housing.

Application Process

- Once you submit an application, you will be put on the transitional housing waiting list.
- When there is a housing vacancy, Town staff will notify you by mail or email to schedule an interview.
- After your interview, Town Staff will confirm your eligibility and notify you in writing within 30 days.
