Nurturing Our Community 	Environmental Stewardship Advisory Board	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide holistic view of environmental resources</li> <li>• Advocate for managing environmental resources in a way that reflect community's values</li> <li>• Assist in developing plans for future parks and greenways corridors</li> <li>• Provide guidance to staff regarding fees, charges and maintenance issues</li> <li>• Walk the greenways and potential greenways to identify problems/suggest maintenance to staff</li> <li>• Advise on management of Town's cemeteries</li> </ul>
A Place for Everyone 	Community Housing Advisory Board	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide holistic view of housing in Chapel Hill</li> <li>• Advocate for community housing decisions and strategies that reflect community's values</li> <li>• Act as an appeals board for Housing Dept.</li> <li>• Assist with selection, monitoring and evaluation of Community Block Grant Program</li> <li>• Assist with implementation of Community Housing Strategy (under development)</li> </ul>
