## **Charge**

Advise, advocate, and plan for comprehensive, safe, effective, and sustainable transportation and connectivity.

## **Scope of Work**

1. Review development applications
2. Advise council on spending
3. Evaluate short and long-term transportation needs
4. Identifying connectivity gaps and safety issues, environmental concerns and other problems
5. Focus on safety police department and fire department support
6. Timelines to ensure action is taken
7. Public private partnerships
8. Request staff to provide data
9. Analyze the bus system for sustainability
10. The Board will be a proactive Vehicle for community feedback (surveys, crowd source)
11. Coordinate with similar groups (Orange County, UNC/Carrboro) in the region and other advisory boards
12. Help develop comprehensive transportation plan
13. Receive feedback from town staff on applications
14. Advocating for transportation and connectivity
15. Catalyzing innovative solutions and identifying outliers for good
16. Aligning transportation and land use planning, economic development, Social Equity, environmental integrity
17. Town’s motor fleet—Environmental Stewardship Board?
18. Chapel Hill Transit
19. UNC Partnership/Carrboro
