- 8. Advise Council on decisions regarding units on site Vs. payments in lieu
- 9. How affordable housing funds are spent
- 10. Review development proposals (types of housing, income levels)
- 11. Consider mixed-use development and range of costs involved in affordable housing
- 12. Consider environmental and conservations concerns involved in development and construction
- 13. Create early community involvement for committee recommendations
- 14. Not responsible for public housing appeals
- 15. Advise Council on guidelines involving community housing
- 16. Assist Council in coordinating and developing priorities in community housing
- 17. Not be involved in public housing appeals
- 18. Rental properties
- 19. Office Space / Mixed use development
- 20. Have input on cost of different development projects
- 21. Realistic goals on parking related to housing
- 22. Engage stakeholders in contributing to housing solutions

Parking Lot Issues

- Composition of board members
- How will application process flow? (development)
- Keep focus <u>narrow</u>
- How many appeals currently go through housing board/director/dept?
- Listening to appeals may require expertise
- Appeals process should <u>not</u> be incorporated into duties of this board
- Two different views on community involvement
 - Board should be made up of experts who create recommendations that community members comment on
 - Community members who do not serve on the board are able to contribute to and comment on board recommendations as they develop
